

# Nigeria Schools Program

### Project Objectives:

- 1. Quality Education for All:** Provide tuition-free, high-quality education to underprivileged children across 17 schools in Lagos State, targeting at least 50 students per school. SchoolTry will enhance school management, enabling real-time connections between administrators, teachers, students, and parents, leading to improved academic performance and engagement.
- 2. Holistic Personal Development:** Focus on the personal development of children and youth aged 11-24 by delivering programs in health, advocacy, skill acquisition, and character formation. The integration of SchoolTry will facilitate virtual classrooms, real-time assessments, and efficient communication, helping students succeed academically and personally.
- 3. Skill Acquisition and Crime Reduction:** By equipping vulnerable youth with relevant skills for the modern job market, the program aims to reduce unemployment and crime. SchoolTry's real-time progress tracking will help identify and address the needs of at-risk students, providing personalized support.
- 4. Alumni Development and Monitoring:** The project will also extend its support to alumni who have transitioned to secondary education. By utilizing SchoolTry's monitoring tools, the Nigeria Schools Program will track and support the continued development of its graduates, ensuring their long-term success.
