

Project Summary: HRGF Christmas With Hope

Overview:

The *Christmas with Hope* project, initiated by the Hope Raisers Global Foundation, is a nationwide food drive aimed at addressing hunger during the festive season amidst Nigeria's economic challenges. It targets poor households and vulnerable groups such as orphans, widows, and people living with disabilities. The project involves partnerships with NGOs, civil societies, and community volunteers, running simultaneously across all 36 states of Nigeria.

The project follows a structured three-phase approach: preparation and planning, procurement and distribution, and post-event activities. Initial steps include meetings, needs assessments, and creating awareness. This leads to the procurement, packaging, and distribution of food items, managed by a volunteer team, with final activities focusing on reviewing feedback and assessing the impact.

Alignment with Project Health Control (PHC) Service:

The PHC Service will play a pivotal role in governance by ensuring efficient project management, monitoring progress, and maintaining compliance with objectives and timelines. Through its oversight, PHC will offer real-time updates, data-driven insights, and risk management, enabling seamless execution and accountability. This approach ensures transparency, aligns resources effectively, and fosters confidence among stakeholders. The project's estimated budget is NGN100,000,000, demonstrating its expansive commitment to addressing food insecurity during Christmas and strengthening community bonds across Nigeria.
