TTGD Eco society Trans Nzoia Kenya is a dynamic social enterprise based in Kitale, Kenya, committed to building sustainable futures, integrating **education, livelihoods, climate action, and social justice**. Founded in 2022, the Society champions values of **truth, integrity, and equity**, striving to uplift marginalized communities including the **landless, displaced persons, women, and vulnerable children**.

Education for All: Early Childhood Development (ECD)

Education lies at the heart of our strategy.

With over **50% of children living below the poverty line** in Trans Nzoia, access to quality early childhood education is limited. Our ECD program addresses this gap by:

- **Establishing 5 new and 25 expanded ECD centers in target areas with high number of out of school children.**
 - Training teachers, caregivers, and community volunteers
 - Providing psychosocial support to children and families
 - Promoting nutrition and school retention through feeding programs
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Agribusiness Innovation: Azolla Farming & Organic Feeds

Our **Farmcare & Agribusiness Hub** pioneers innovative organic agriculture through:

- **Azolla farming** – a fast-growing aquatic fern rich in protein, used for:
 - **Livestock feed** (especially poultry)
 - **Biofertilizer** to enrich soils and reduce synthetic inputs
- **Training local farmers** in organic feed production and fertilizer blending

- **Reducing reliance on imported synthetic fertilizers**, aligning with Kenya's food security agenda
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Livelihoods protection & Nutrition Through Sustainable Poultry

Our integrated model includes poultry farming, where organic Azolla feed supports:

- **Improved egg production**
 - **Affordable feed alternatives** for low-income families
 - **Hands-on training for women and youth** in value-chain agribusiness
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Psychosocial Support and Protection

In response to chronic post-election violence and systemic poverty, our community network—**Trans Nzoia Regional Team Network (TRTN)**—has supported over 5,400 families through:

- **Safe spaces for children and families**
- **Counseling, trauma support, and parenting programs**
- **Referral networks for health, legal aid, and social services**
